Federal Stalking Law Definition and Sentences In extreme cases of cyberbullying, federal stalking charges can be filed. In such a case, a person is put in reasonable fear of death or serious injury to herself, her family, or a spouse/partner. Sentences in such cases can be anywhere from five to 20 years.

One thing that's really important to note with anti-bullying legislation in general is that it holds teachers and schools accountable for reporting and acting in case of it - and that includes cyber bullying. Georgia anti-bullying laws cover cyberbullying that occurs off-campus if the electronic communication (1) is directed specifically at students or school personnel, (2) is maliciously intended for the purpose of threatening the safety of those specified or substantially disrupting the orderly operation of the school, and (3) creates a reasonable fear of harm to the students' or school personnel's person or property or has a high likelihood of succeeding in that purpose.
